Dear ladies and gentlemen, dear colleagues,

On behalf of the entire organization team, we invite you to the annual conference of the German Society for Pediatric Cardiology and Congenital Heart Defects 2024 in Hamburg.

After the very successful and lively annual conferences of the two societies in 2023, we would like to discuss current and future challenges in the areas of pediatric heart medicine and adults with congenital heart defects next year according to the motto "Mission Future".

Despite the rapid medical and technical developments that lead to improved treatment options and a longer survival of children and adults with congenital heart defects, long-term morbidities and comorbidities in these patients will become increasingly important in the future. PRESENTATION REGISTRATION

Presentation applications can only be submitted electronically and in English via the websites <u>www.dgthg-jahrestagung.de</u> and <u>www.dgpk-jahrestagung.de</u>.

Abstracts have to be structured according to the following guidelines:

- 1. Structure: Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusion
- 2. Extent/Length: max. 2,500 characters for the abstract text incl. blanks (without title, authors, institutes)
- 3. Illustrations: max. 1 table incl. a maximum of 10 lines / 10 splits (50 characters per line will be subtracted from the total text)

Please note, according to the guidelines for continuing education measures of the state medical associations, company or product names may not be mentioned in the entire abstract under any circumstances.

Furthermore, abstracts may not be submitted if they have been published before or submitted elsewhere. The program committee will, of course, review all abstracts for potential multiple publication. Should redundancy become apparent, this will lead to immediate rejection in almost all cases. Exceptions may be made in cases of particular importance to cardiac science. However, publication in the supplement of the journal The Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgeon is at the discretion of the editors.

If there are any questions in this regard, it is the responsibility of the corresponding author to consult directly with the editor of the journal ThCVS, Markus K. Heinemann.
